The program seeks to prepare students for conversational English language skills with both non-native and native American English Teachers.

It will also give participants the opportunity to gain an appreciation for U.S. culture and values, increase their ability to participate successfully in the socio-economic development of Spain, and improve their ability to compete to participate in future U.S. educational and exchange programs.

- Be a Spanish national or a resident in Spain.
- Be enrolled in 3rd ESO in a public or charter school.
- Grade Point Average of 6,00 in 1st ESO.
- Possess an elemental level of English.
- Household income below the Madrid household income average.
